

*****Note***** Racing Stock applications WILL BE REJECTED WITH NO REFUND OF FEE if all requirements are not met, including submitting ORIGINAL Foal Certificate (copy not acceptable), by December 31 of the three-year-old year.

*****Note***** Broodmare & Stallion applications WILL BE REJECTED WITH NO REFUND OF FEE if all requirements are not met within one (1) year from date the OHRC receives the application.

OKLAHOMA-BRED REGISTRATION SCHEDULE

RACING STOCK - requires Application, Fee, and Original Foal Certificate (photocopy NOT acceptable):

Foals in Year of birth by December 31.....	\$ 25
Yearlings by June 1 of Yearling Year.....	\$ 50
All Racing Stock After June 1 of Yearling Year through December 31 of Three-Year-Old Year.....	\$ 500
All Racing Stock On or After January 1 of Four-Year-Old Year and Up.....	\$1,000

PERMANENT BROODMARE REGISTRY - requires Application, Fee, and copy of Certificate of Registration:

By December 31 of year prior to foaling	\$ 35
<u>Under Late Application</u> (after December 31 and prior to foaling)	\$ 70
Hardship Application (mares registered as Racing Stock but not transferred to Broodmare).....	\$ 200 PLUS regular fee
Re-accreditation (OK-Bred broodmares that left Oklahoma then returned to Oklahoma to resume domicile).....	Same as above

PERMANENT STALLION REGISTRY - requires Application, Fee, and copy of Certificate of Registration:

By February 1 prior to breeding season	\$ 100
<u>Under Late Application</u> (after February 1 and by June 30 of breeding season for remainder of season)	\$ 200
Re-accreditation (OK-Bred stallions that left Oklahoma then returned to Oklahoma to stand at stud)	Same as above

IMPORTANT NOTICES AND REMINDERS FROM THE OKLAHOMA HORSE RACING COMMISSION:

1. Accredited Oklahoma-Bred Racing Stock are not automatically registered as accredited Oklahoma-Bred Breeding stock. Accredited Racing stock not transferred to the Permanent Broodmare Registry prior to foaling an otherwise eligible foal may now be registered in the Permanent Broodmare Registry under the new Hardship Rules and the foal is still eligible to be registered. See Fee Schedule and Rules.
2. New owners of accredited Oklahoma-Bred horses (including breeding stock) must file a transfer form, \$10 fee and a copy of the certificate of registration showing transfer of ownership and date of transfer. Oklahoma-Bred awards will be placed on hold until transfers are received by the Commission. Awards on hold for more than (1) year will be forfeited. Contact the Commission for transfer forms.
3. Oklahoma-Bred awards that are unclaimed within one (1) year from the date of the race in which the award was earned will be considered forfeited by the award earner. Forfeited awards will remain in or be returned to the Oklahoma-Bred fund for distribution pursuant to provisions of law.
4. Oklahoma-Bred registration application forms are revised periodically. An application will be rejected if no fee, incorrect fee and/or a Commission approved application form is not submitted to the OHRC. DO NOT send materials to any organization other than the OHRC.
5. Accredited stallions will forfeit their accreditation if they leave the state for reasons other than racing, medical treatment or performance. In such event, to become re-accredited, an application form and fee must be filed. See OHRC rules.
6. The definition of Breeder is: for Thoroughbreds, the breeder is the owner or lessee of record of the broodmare at the time of foaling, for all breeds other than Thoroughbred, the breeder is the owner or lessee of record of the broodmare at the time of conception.
