REVISION 2.

On May 29th, 2007 the OQHRA board of directors met and voted unanimously to amend the 2007 Tulsa Tribal Purse Fund Directive to direct previously unallocated funds available for purses in 2007 to Blue Ribbon Downs. At the time the original 2007 directive was submitted, the purse committee anticipated there would be an additional direction to the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission for moneys available for purses in 2007 but not previously allocated. In the original Directive the intentions of the purse committees were clearly stated and provided that additional directives would allocate the remaining available purse money with the intention to provide as nearly as possible a comparable level of purses for Quarter Horses, Paints, and Appaloosa's for each of the Oklahoma racetracks. Blue Ribbon Downs is the only Oklahoma racetrack with a remaining schedule of live race days and a projected average purse per race level less than the purses offered at Remington Park, Will Rogers Downs, or Fair Meadows for the race year 2007. This revision to the original directive will provide for additional purse supplements for purses for Quarter Horses, Paints, and Appaloosas at Blue Ribbon Downs.

As of July 1, 2007 the purse committee has revised it's analysis of the revenue available in the Tulsa Area Tribal Purse Fund for Quarter Horses, Paints, and Appaloosa's and makes the following additional directions:

QUARTER HORSE:

The purse committee directs placement of an additional \$1,000,000 (One Million Dollars) to Blue Ribbon Downs Quarter Horse purses to be used as follows:

\$900,000 (Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars) shall be used to increase the average purse per race in overnight purse races .

\$100,000 (One Hundred Thousand Dollars) shall be used to offer 5 additional Stakes races with \$20,000 added to each race. The additional Stakes races shall have a nomination period that closes not less than 48 hours prior to the running of the race and require an entry fee to participate which will be added to the purse. The racing secretary will offer one race for two (2) year olds, one race for three (3) year olds, one race at a distance of 870 yards, one race for three (3) and up Fillies and Mares, and one race for three (3) and up.


