

RULE IMPACT STATEMENT

TITLE 325. OKLAHOMA HORSE RACING COMMISSION CHAPTER 1. COMMISSION POWERS AND JURISDICTION

A. **PURPOSE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING.**

The Ad Hoc Committee on Rules and Medication has proposed amendments to include but not be limited to amend definitions, add definitions, change terms such as from 'medication' to 'substance', and update the home office address.

B. **CLASSES OF PEOPLE WHO MOST LIKELY WILL BE AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENTS AND ANY INFORMATION ON COST IMPACTS RECEIVED BY THE AGENCY FROM ANY PRIVATE OR PUBLIC ENTITIES.**

The proposed rule amendments affect persons regulated by the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission. No cost impacts have been received to date.

C. **CLASSES OF PEOPLE WHO WILL BENEFIT BY PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENTS.**

Persons who engage in the business of horse racing in Oklahoma will benefit from the proposed rule amendments.

D. **DESCRIPTION OF THE PROBABLE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENTS UPON AFFECTED CLASSES OF PERSONS.**

There is no anticipated economic impact of the proposed rule amendments upon the classes of persons.
