CHAPTER 45. PROHIBITED PRACTICES AND EQUINE TESTING**

RULEMAKING ACTION:

Notice of proposed PERMANENT rulemaking.

PROPOSED RULE:

Chapter 45. Prohibited Practices and Equine Testing [AMENDED]

SUMMARY:

The Ad Hoc Committee on Rules and Medication has proposed amendments to include but not be limited to amend definitions, add definitions, update the version citation for the UNIFORM CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES OF FOREIGN SUBSTANCES document, and correct the spelling of a substance.

AUTHORITY:

75 O.S., §303; Title 3A O.S. §204(A); Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission.
